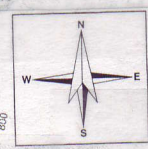

Cougar Series Trail Runs - 13 Mile Course (start at Sky Country Trailhead)

- straight on Clay Pit Rd. -Left Coyote Creek (N4) -Right on Klondyke Swamp (N5)
- Left Lost Beagle (N6) -Right/straight Anti Aircraft Ridge (N7) -Right Cougar Pass (N8) -Left Klondyke Swamp (N5)
- Cross Clay Pit Rd. -Straight on to Fred's RR Grade (C7) -Left Shy Bear (S2) -Left up Wilderness Peak (E4)
- Right Wilderness Cliffs (E5) -Right Wilderness Creek (E6) -Left Long View Peak (S4) -Right/straight on Deceiver (S3)
- Left on Shy Bear (S2) -Left Far Country (S1) -Right Indian Trail (W7) -Left on De Leo Wall (W9)
- Right/straight Marshall Hill (W6) -Right Indian Trail (W7) -Left Quarry (C6) -Left on Freds (C7) -Left By Pass (C9)
- Right Cave Hole (C3) -Left Old Man trail
