Cougar 7.5. Mile Course

- From Clay Pit Road
- Left on Coyote Creek N4
- Right on Klondike Swamp N5
- Left on Lost Beagle N6
- Turns into Anti Aircraft Ridge N7
- Right on Cougar Pass N8
- Left on Klondike Swamp N5
- Cross Rd. to Fred's RR C7
- Left on Shy Bear S2
- Right on Long View Peak S4
- Right on Deciever S3
- Right on Shy Bear S2
- Left on Fred's C7
- Left on Bypass C9
- Right on Cave Hole C3
- Left onto Old Man's to parking lot.
